

5 national parks in the country



National parks are created based on the IUCN criteria

All national parks fall under IUCN management category II.



Every national park is managed by independent entity

The National Park administration – the State Service for Protected Areas under the Ministry of Environment coordinates activities in 4 of the national parks.



National parks – land ownership

Publicly owned land in National parks is managed by Forests Enterprise, Land Service or National Parks administrations. All area of Curonian Spit national park is publicly owned.



Wilderness zones in national parks vary greatly

There are various types of wilderness zones and it is not possible to estimate their extent.



There are conflicts of interests with construction activities and forestry



Voluntary entrance fees from 1 to 25 EUR are charged

Depending on the park, whole area or just some attractions are charged (viewpoints, treetop walks, canoe rides, caves).
