National parks were created based on the IUCN criteria II



National parks are managed based on contracts by several public institutions.

National Forest Administration (Rosilva), other public institutions, local communities



The ownership of land in national parks is mixed with about half being publicly owned

This share differs across areas and the data is not completely reliable



Wilderness zones represent 6.9 % of the area of national parks

Wilderness mostly consists of the core areas



There are some conflicts of interests with forestry

Forestry management sometimes interferes with conservation measures proposed for protection of species and habitats.



Some attractions are charged (viewpoints, treetop walks, canoe rides, caves, etc.)

The entrance fee is collected in booths by the trails with employees. Also car entrance is charged.
