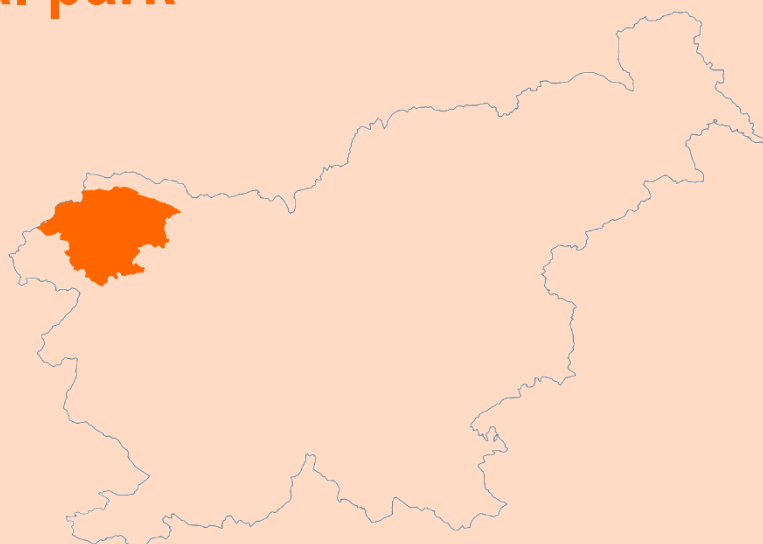


Slovenia's national park

Triglav National Park



Protected areas are partially created based on the IUCN criteria

The national park has a mixed category (national park and protected landscape)



4 organizations manage land in national park

Farmland and Forest Fund, State Forests Enterprise, Slovenia Water Agency, State Service for Protected Areas, municipalities



46 % of the area of national parks is owned by state and municipalities

Private owners are compensated through long-term agreements, payments for desired outcome and private land is purchased and interchanged as well



Wilderness zones take up to 37% of the national park area

First nature conservation area, wilderness is complemented with e.g. traditional alpine pastures



There are some conflicts of interests with agriculture, tourism, water management and forestry



Some attractions of the national park are charged

Entrance fee charged in other state protected areas (e.g. Nature Park Skocjan Caves, Secovlje Salina Nature Park)
