- Awareness raising

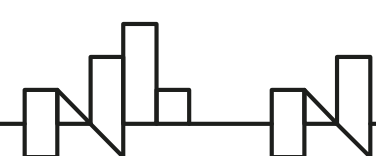

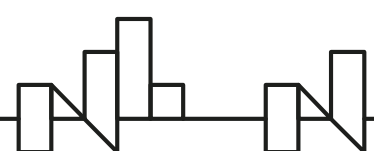
